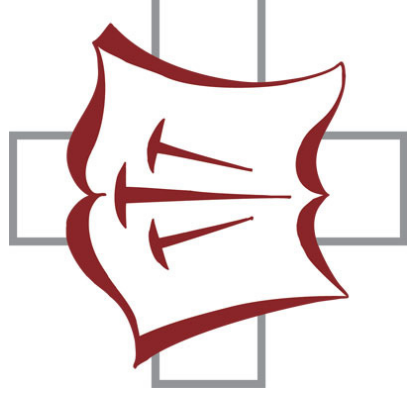
Nicene Creed
