Cold Weather Guidelines

1. Students must wear jackets when the temperature falls below 60 degrees
2. At temperatures below 45 degrees, students will need to have ears covered and some type of gloves or mittens
3. Students who do not have ear coverings/mittens/gloves will remain in their seats and be involved in quiet activities during the break
4. When the temperature/wind chill is colder than 20 degrees, students will have the option of going outside or staying inside
5. At temperatures below zero, students who go outside may only stay outside for periods of 15 minutes; they must then come back inside
