## Cold Weather Guidelines

- 1. Students must wear jackets when the temperature falls below 60 degrees
- 2. At temperatures below 45 degrees, students will need to have ears covered and some type of gloves or mittens
- 3. Students who do not have ear coverings/mittens/gloves will remain in their seats and be involved in quiet activities during the break
- 4. When the temperature/wind chill is colder than 20 degrees, students will have the option of going outside or staying inside
- 5. At temperatures below zero, students who go outside may only stay outside for periods of 15 minutes; they must then come back inside
